

Q: What is Worship Camp?

A: Worship Camp is a fun and engaging experience for kids filled with worship, crafts, games, with outreach and more in a welcoming environment.

Q: When will Worship Camp take place?

A: Worship Camp will be held June 22–26 from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM each day.

Q: Where is the camp located?

A: The camp will take place at the Chambersburg campus - Kids Wing.

Q: Who can attend Worship Camp?

A: Children entering 1st grade through those entering 6th grade in the fall are welcome to register.

Q: How can I register my child?

A: A registration link will be available starting May 3 for parents to sign up their children.

Q: Can I volunteer for Worship Camp?

A: Yes! The same link will also allow individuals to sign up as volunteers. Note: All volunteers must attend a training scheduled for June 17th from 6-7:30 at Chambersburg campus.

Q: What kinds of activities will my child participate in?

A: Kids will enjoy a variety of activities including worship, crafts, games, and other fun experiences designed just for them.

Q: Is there a cost to attend Worship Camp?

A: this is a free event however registration is a must!

Q: What should my child bring each day?

A: children attending are encouraged to bring a water bottle with their name clearly labeled on it

Q: What should my child wear?

A: Comfortable clothes suitable for active play and crafts. sneakers or tennis shoes only. Please no crocs, sandals, or flip flops

Q: Who will be supervising the children?

A: volunteers who have completed our KidsPoint onboarding process .

Q: How does drop-off and pick-up work?

A: Students will check in with our church kiosk as they normally do during church services on Sunday- parents must show their parent codes at dismissal



Q: What if my child has allergies or medical needs?

A: Any allergies or medical needs be discussed prior to camp to ensure proper accommodations are in place. We kindly ask that you share any medical concerns you may have when completing the registration.

Q: Can my child attend if they can't come every day?

A: we do encourage daily participation however understand if there are some scheduling conflicts and your child may need to miss a day. We kindly ask that you share any conflicts you may have with attendance when completing the registration.

Q: What is the daily schedule like?

A: Students participating will be placed into two groups, engaging with daily devotional, learn at least 2 worship songs, enjoy snack that will be provided daily, and groups will rotate through craft & game times & share the gospel to Our outreach to the YMCA camp students
